

DONATION OPTIONS

OPTION #1 – ROOM SPONSORSHIP - \$10,000

With this option, an area or bedroom is sponsored. A plaque with your family last name, organization and/or business will be displayed at the room entrance or where the Rice Lodge Board determines appropriate. Bedrooms that are sponsored by families may be furnished with family owned furniture. Family pictures and/or family history are encouraged as display items in these rooms. If you prefer to donate to a common area such as a lounge, office, or kitchen, no furniture donation will be necessary.

We have included a pre-typed explanation letter that can be copied and used by families who want to make a collective contribution effort. One family, with the financial support of moms and dads, aunts and uncles, kids and cousins, can go a long ways in preserving the family name and family history. And sponsoring a room comes with a five-year perk of seven free rooms per year. This is explained more extensively on the Sponsorship form.

OPTION #2 – DONAR AWARD AREA

General donations can also be made to this project. They will be applied to the restoration costs and purchase of needed items to furnish the facility. A framed list of donors will be on display in the building. Donor categories include:

BRONZE	-	\$100.00 to \$499.99
SILVER	-	\$500.00 to \$999.99
GOLD	-	\$1,000.00 to 2,499.99
PLATIUM	-	\$2,500.00 and more

This is a great way for recognition by individual and/or groups. Some examples for group donations could be businesses, medical associations, historical societies, and high school graduating classes, clubs, and/or organizations, foundations, and charitable groups. This is also a perfect way to cherish loved ones with “memorial”.
